



## Procès-verbal of signature

on behalf of the Republic of Latvia,  
of the Council of Europe Convention for the  
Protection of the Profession of Lawyer.

On the twenty-third day of October, Two thousand and Twenty-five, at the seat of the Council of Europe in Strasbourg, Ms Inese LĪBIŅA-EGNERE, Minister of Justice of Latvia, invested with full powers on behalf of her Government, signed the Council of Europe Convention for the Protection of the Profession of Lawyer (CETS No. 226), opened for signature by the member States of the Council of Europe, the non-member States that have participated in its elaboration and the European Union, in Luxembourg, on 13 May 2025.
