Dear Ambassador,

Your Government has generously provided personnel to EUMM Georgia Mission.

Subject to the adoption of another Council Decision extending the Mission's Mandate and approving the appropriate Budgetary Impact Statement, **I would therefore like to request the extension of the tour of duty of the Mission Member(s) in the position(s) as indicated in the table attached.** Should the extension not be granted, I kindly request your authorities to arrange for the return of the Mission Member(s).

I would appreciate receiving the confirmation of extension or non-extension at your earliest convenience, **but not later than 23/08/2021.** All requests for extension should be processed exclusively through the Goalkeeper – Registrar system.

I respectfully draw your attention to the fact that all personnel-related costs for secondment are under the responsibility of the EU Member State/contributing third State, including salaries, medical coverage, travel expenses to and from the Mission area (including home leave), and allowances other than those paid according to the Council documents 7291/09 (10 March 2009) and 9084/13 (30 April 2013).
