Procès-verbal of signature

on behalf of the Republic of Latvia,
of Protocol No. 16 to the Convention for the
Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental
Freedoms.

On the second day of June, Two thousand and Twenty-five, at the seat of the Council of Europe in Strasbourg, Ms Agnese VILDE, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary, Permanent Representative of Latvia to the Council of Europe, invested with full powers on behalf of her Government, signed, subject to ratification, Protocol No. 16 to the Convention for the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms (CETS No. 214), which was opened for signature by the High Contracting Parties to the Convention, in Strasbourg, on 2 October 2013.

In witness whereof this procès-verbal has been drawn up and signed by Ms Agnese VILDE and Mr Bjørn BERGE, Deputy Secretary General of the Council of Europe, in two copies, of which one will be handed to the Permanent Representative of Latvia and the other deposited in the Archives of the Council of Europe.
